3. To discuss and approve the revised curriculum for –

TYBA Sem 4 and 5 Compulsory English – Reflections Through Literature I & Reflections Through Literature 2

i) Dr. Kunal Ray suggested that more women poets and women authors should be included in the syllabi of both Compulsory English I and II.

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i) Both Dr. Sachin Labade and Prof. Kunal Ray suggested that there should be English translations of Bhasa Literatures that is regional language literature, in the poetry section, since the course is titled Indian Literature.

7. To discuss and approve the revised curriculum for - **TYBA Honours Core Course – Research Methodology**

i) Dr. Sachin Labade and Prof. Kunal Ray both suggested that one section of the course should include components like genre-wise research possibilities. They also suggested that the course need to introduce students to possibilities of research in areas like African literature, Canadian literature or Language studies.
