#### 3. To discuss and approve the revised curriculum for FYBA

The following course was presented in the meeting to seek approval of the BOS members – **FYBA** – An Introduction to Literature 2

UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED THAT the revised course for FYBA was approved without any changes and suggestions.

#### 4. To discuss and approve the revised curriculum for M.A.-Semester II

- a) English Literature 1798 1914
- b) English Literature 1914 2000
- c) Literary Theory and Criticism 1
- d) Studying Gender Through Literature

Suggestions: The members have discussed and given following suggestions for the MA Courses:

- Dr. Prabhanjan Mane suggested number of lecture hours to be allotted to the teaching of the play, *Riders to the Sea*, by J. M. Synge, to be increased from 2 hours to 3 or 4 hours.
- For the MA course, English Literature 1914-2000, Dr. Prabhanjan Mane suggested a
  woman playwright to be included in the Plays section. A play by either Caryl
  Churchill or Sarah Daniels was suggested
- For the MA course, English Literature 1914 2000, Ms. Ananya Dutta suggested any woman poet to be included in the poetry section alongside Hilda Doolittle.
- Since the MA course, English Literature 1914-2000, features many non-British writers, both Dr. Prabhanjan Mane and Dr. Ashutosh Potdar suggested texts by non-British writers to be replaced by texts written by British writers, as the course has been titled English Literature 1914-2000, or else it was suggested that the title of the course should be changed to Modern and Post-modern Literatures
- The MA course Literary Theory and Criticism 1 was unanimously accepted, and no changes were recommended.

- For the MA course, Studying Gender Through Literature, Dr. Ruchi Jaggi suggested any speculative fiction to be included.
- The MA course, Studying Gender Through Literature, was appreciated by all and was accepted.
