#### Resolutions:

**TYBCOM (Advanced Accountancy papers)** 

CA Umesh Kulkarni Sir, Head of the Department, Accountancy has presented the roadmap for the FYBCOM, SYBCOM and TYBCOM Accountancy syllabus to be modified in future. Sir has further presented the proposed syllabus of TYBCOM Accountancy as a compulsory paper with following proposed modifications in the current syllabus. The proposed syllabus was unanimously approved in the meeting.

- Topic on Consolidation of holding and subsidiary reduction in the no. of lectures from 16 to 14.
- Topic on Amalgamation- reduction in the no. of lectures from 16 to 14.
- AS 7, AS 11, AS 19, and AS 20 Additional numerical sums on Construction Contracts, Foreign Exchange fluctuation, EPS, AS- 22 DTA with calculations- Increase in no of lectures from 6 to 8.

- Introduction to Auditing- to remove transitional provisions of auditor's appointment- reduction in the no. of lectures from 6 to 4
- Ratio Analysis to be swapped with Cash Flow Statement -- 10 lectures
- Addition of new chapter- Accounting for GST in Tally 4 lectures

Above mentioned are the modifications in the current syllabus approved by the BOS members. CS Mahesh Athavale Sir and CA Saransh Dey Sir have given valuable suggestions and inputs that will be incorporated while framing the whole Accountancy Syllabus in future.
