






The Curriculum comprises learning values in terms of concepts, knowledge, analytical abilities or broadening perspectives.




### 3. The Curriculum enhances your scope to develop entrepreneurial skills.




#### 4. The Curriculum is career oriented.




### 5. The Classroom learning experience was very encouraging.




## 6. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?




#### 7. How well were the teachers able to communicate?




## 8. The Teachers approach to teaching can best be described as:




# 9. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD Projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?




### 10. The Teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.




# 11. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, Course outcomes and programme outcomes.






# 13. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.




14. The College/teachers use students centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.




# 15. the teaching and mentoring process in your college facilities you in intellectual, social and emotional growth.




## The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your college is very good.




## 17. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.




### 18. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?




### 19. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.




### 20. Teacher encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.




# 21. The college takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




