### Earth Day Seminar 2023

The Department of Geography in association with Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability, Symbiosis International University, organised an Earth Day Seminar on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2023. The Theme of the Event was

Urban Environmental Sustainability.

The event began with a keynote speech by Prof. Amitav Mallik,he addresses the issues concerning overpopulation along with which the use of critical resources is getting exploited. The overpopulation has also led to unequal distribution. He emphasized the point that as per the government's perspectives-Development should be prioritized along with considering lowering the carbon emission on the individual level. He highlighted the quote 'Problems are global but solutions are local'. The world needs rapid decarbonization for the well-being of all living beings.



The next speaker was Dr Anil Gokarn who talked about how we need an immediate action plan to tackle these environmental issues. He concentrated on the waste management system which generally prevails in towns and cities of India and highlighted its lacunas leading to land, air and water pollution due to improper waste management. He shared a fact that in a year 2 billion tons of waste is generated on a global level and according to the World Bank, India produces the waste which is 277 million tons of the total globe. Out of this 60% is organic waste which with the proper system can be reused by making it a part of the soil. His social entrepreneurship venture, 'Pro Earth' is a company which is working since 2010 towards creating sustainable solutions to tackle with enormous waste generated in Pune and Pimpri Chinchwad cities. The Pune city alone generates 900-1000 tons of waste per day, out of which only 20% is recycled which is mainly plastic waste.

Dr Prakash Rao emphasized how urbanization has negatively impacted the environment and atmosphere. The concept of using energy efficiently, water management strategies and how the way we use transportation can be changed for the better. To decrease traffic congestion, and air pollution, and to enhance health, we should encourage sustainable transportation methods including walking, cycling, and public transportation. Create bike lanes, footpaths, and public transportation networks to encourage people to opt for these alternatives over driving, etc.

At last, Dr Om Prakash spoke about how there is no alternative to Earth and that whatever damage humans have done can be reversed if taken proper measures as he believes that every economy has an ability to manage its waste and actions. The main themes he highlighted were drivers of climate change, the increase in global temperature, the need for waste separation, solid waste management, landfill leachate and how is it related to the environment and humans. He presented various research on how different chemicals which are the result of urbanization cause the environment to degrade. He focuses on how different human actions lead to an increase in waste dumping in landfills. These landfills end up being a major cause of pollutants and contamination of land and water resources which directly harmfully impacts living beings. Sir also presents a comparative view of sanitary and unprotected landfills and how different gases like CO2, N2O and other toxic gases are dispersed in the environment. He even suggested that the solution to make our city sustainable is to form a sustainable community by bringing diversity together, communicating and interacting while working towards a common goal of achieving sustainable living.

The program later had a Pune Climate Warrior section where two climate buddies explained the initiative which was proposed by Rajya Sabha MP Adv. Vandana Chavan and executed by Divya Chavan. The volunteer students rightly known as 'Climate Buddies' were felicitated by distributing certificates for their valuable contribution. The program further proceeded with the Avni presentation contest based on specific environmental and urbanization-related themes followed by prize distribution for PCW and winners of the Avni contest.


#### **1.** Symbipreneurs - Benchmark

# Placement Cell Report 2022-23

The Placement Cell at Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce is a distinguished professional body established with the primary objective of facilitating the recruitment of the brightest minds from across the country into leading multinational corporations. With steadfast commitment to



ensuring the ultimate satisfaction of both students and companies, the Placement Cell serves as a seamless interface, connecting students to their dream jobs and meeting the staffing needs of employers. Under the able leadership of Dr. Nilesh Waghmare and the unwavering support of student coordinators Ektha S., Shuchi Shekdar, Rohit Singh, and Krishnanand D. Shenoi, the Placement Cell offers comprehensive guidance and training to students throughout the year. The Placement Cell Team works tirelessly behind the scenes to ensure the smooth functioning of recruitment drives, aligning its efforts with the College's vision of empowering students to meet the dynamic demands of the corporate world.

The Placement Cell of SCAC is proud to announce its exceptional achievement in successfully placing a remarkable total of 202 students until the 30th of April 2023, showcasing a significant year-on-year increase of 31.1% from 154 students placed last year. The recruitment drives for the current batch, 2022-23, commenced as early as mid-July and continued throughout the year, with some companies still actively conducting their recruitment process. As colleges reopened for offline classes, we were privileged to have most companies join us on campus for physical interviews, generating a positive response. As the Placement Cell, we owe the success of the procedure throughout the year to the relentless co-operation of the coordinators, faculty, HRs, and students.

The Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce Placement Cell takes immense pride in the success of its efforts towards enabling students to achieve their career aspirations. The academic year 2022-23 witnessed a remarkable rise in the number of companies showing interest in hiring from our esteemed institution. Over 25 companies exhibited their interest, out of which 22 actively recruited from our campus. This number also included 12 new organizations, who entrusted our students with their job requirements. The Placement Cell aims to establish enduring relationships with our current and new associates and eagerly anticipates their presence on our campus in the future.

The companies that visited our campus during the year were Deloitte USI, Credit Suisse, EY India, D.E Shaw India, BNY Mellon (Bank of New York Mellon), TresVista Financial Services, Barclays India, Tata Consultancy Services (TCS), Deloitte India, GOMO Group, Deutsche Bank, KPMG India, Alliance Bernstein (AB), CFOLogic, Northern Trust, British Petroleum (BP), TopHire, Kohler GSS, Federal Bank, Ditto Insurance, HCLTech, TechnoEdge, XQtiv Consulting and many more.

The procedure for selection included receiving the Job Description, Registration of Students, Pre-Placement Talk, Aptitude Test, Group Discussions, Rounds of Interviews, the Final Selection of Students, and Acceptance of Offer Letters.

#### **Internship Support:**



Additionally, the Placement Cell also coordinates with companies to provide internship opportunities to students for their holistic development. This year, the Placement Cell, saw a rise in the number of Internships offered to the students of Second and First Year. A few big names like D.E Shaw India (through InFinity Internship programme), Alliance Bernstein, A.P. Moller- Maersk, Deloitte USI (through the GSM Maverick programme) came on campus and selected students for internships. D.E Shaw India also provided opportunities to first year female students through its FinSpire Fellowship programme.

During the academic year, the college was able to provide internships to 27 of its students through its Placement Cell.

#### **Career Counseling and Corporate Readiness Activities:**

1. The Placement Cell at Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce is committed to preparing its students for successful careers in the corporate world. To achieve this goal, it conducted a comprehensive three-day Online 'Workshop on Corporate Readiness' prior to the commencement of the placement season. The workshop aimed to provide students with a thorough understanding of the selection procedure for campus placements.

Distinguished industry experts, with years of experience in the corporate world, were invited to enlighten students on key areas such as resume writing, group discussions, aptitude tests, and personal interviews. The guest speakers included Ms. Devaki Purohit, Ms. Neha Pant Tewari, Ms. Gunjan Deshpande and Mr. Akshat Bhatnagar, who shared their valuable insights and guided our students on how to excel in the placement process. This workshop was a valuable learning experience for the students.

- 2. The process of campus placements can often leave students feeling overwhelmed and uncertain about how to proceed. To address this issue, the SCAC Placement Cell organized a 'Doubt Clearance Session' with the aim of guiding and clarifying the students' doubts regarding the placement process. The session was conducted by Ms. Ridhi Chourasia, a former Placement Cell Co-ordinator at SCAC, who provided insights and answered questions based on her own experience. This initiative proved to be a beneficial forum for the students to seek guidance and overcome any apprehensions they may have had.
- **3.** In addition to these, the SCAC Placement Cell also organized a two-day workshop, on 'Corporate Culture and Ethics' which was conducted by Mr. Advait Kurlekar and Mr. Shirish Limaye, who gave significant inputs on the importance of taking the high road in the corporate world.
- **4.** The SCAC Placement Cell took an initiative to enhance the skill sets of the students placed in esteemed organizations such as Deloitte USI, EY India, KPMG India, Deloitte India, Deutsche Bank, amongst others, by organizing an 'Online Certificate Course in



Audit'. The course, spanning over a duration of 30 hours, has been meticulously designed, and conducted by expert trainer, Ms. Archana Shankar, and was delivered through MS Teams. The course aimed to provide comprehensive knowledge about the intricacies of audit processes, thereby aiding the students to stay abreast with the latest industry trends and practices.

5. An 'Orientation to Campus Placement and Internship Drives' was also conducted by the Placement Cell Co-ordinators; Ektha S., Shuchi Shekdar, Rohit Singh and Krishnanand D. Shenoi to help the second and first-year students to have a thorough understanding of the placement process, job opportunities in different companies with various roles and the functioning system and role of the Placement Cell of our college.

To date, a total of 25 companies have approached us, out of which 12 were new companies including Barclays India, Kohler GSS, Alliance Bernstein, Tata Consultancy Services, British Petroleum, D.E Shaw India, KPMG India, AP Moller- Maersk, among others. The highest CTC offered to PG students is 8.05 LPA and to UG students is 21.5 LPA. The average package for UG students and PG students is 5.51 LPA and 7.63 LPA respectively.

This year, the Placement Cell broke all records in terms of highest CTC, No. of students placed, No. of companies visited, No. of new companies visited. We are committed to maintaining this upward trend while shaping young minds into capable, dynamic, and committed managers and leaders in the modern corporate world. The Placement Cell wishes its students the best of luck in all their future endeavours.



## 1) Guest Lecture & Pune Climate Warrior Inauguration Program on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2022:

- 1) Dr. Gurudas Nulkar Professor & Director, Centre for Sustainable Development; Gokhale Institute of Politics and Economics
- 2) Dr. Om Prakash- Head, Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change & Sustainability, SIU In this program students were made aware about the impacts of Climate Change by Dr. Om Prakash. Dr. Gurudas Nulkar motivated our student volunteers to connect with school students for creating environmental awareness. Mrs. Divya Chavan provided a training to the students about how to approach schools and conduct activities for associated school students.

#### 2) Extension Program-Pune Climate Warrior Project :

• The Pune Climate Warrior Project field work initiated from November 2022 and continued till February 2023. Our students participated in a collaborative project Pune Climate Warriors program that was initiated by an NGO named ALERT in association with Vanrai and Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability. Pune Climate Warriors program is launched with a vision of sensitizing them about the environment and collectively acting towards reducing our carbon footprint to effectively deal with climate change. In this program, 60 schools in and around Pune city participate. From our college 45 students registered as Climate Buddies. These 45 Climate Buddies visited the schools and organized various competitions and projects with school children in association with teachers. One of our own retired staff members Dr. Swati Dixit has initiated a Start-up named 'Ojasya' for popularizing the bio enzymes cleaning products. These products are toxins free and environment friendly which contributes to reduce water pollution. We received all 10 entries for this competition. The presentations and Q&A sessions were meticulously and sincerely conducted by jury members. We got two winners for AVNI 2023, both the winning teams are from Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce.

#### 7) Earth Day Seminar 2023

The Department of Geography in association with Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability, Symbiosis International University, organised an Earth Day Seminar on 5<sup>th</sup> April 2023. The Theme of the Event was

Urban Environmental Sustainability.

The distinguished speakers for the event are



Chief Guest - Anil Gorkarn- Director, ProEarth

Dr. Prakash Rao – Head, Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability , SIU, Pune

Dr. Om Prakash- Deputy Head, Symbiosis Centre for Climate Change and Sustainability, SIU, Pune

The event began with a keynote speech by Prof. Amitav Mallik,he addresses the issues concerning overpopulation along with which the use of critical resources is getting exploited. The overpopulation has also led to unequal distribution. He emphasized the point that as per the government's perspectives-Development should be prioritized along with considering lowering the carbon emission on the individual level. He highlighted the quote 'Problems are global but solutions are local'. The world needs rapid decarbonization for the well-being of all living beings.

The next speaker was Dr Anil Gokarn who talked about how we need an immediate action plan to tackle these environmental issues. He concentrated on the waste management system which generally prevails in towns and cities of India and highlighted its lacunas leading to land, air and water pollution due to improper waste management. He shared a fact that in a year 2 billion tons of waste is generated on a global level and according to the World Bank, India produces the waste which is 277 million tons of the total globe. Out of this 60% is organic waste which with the proper system can be reused by making it a part of the soil. His social entrepreneurship venture, 'Pro Earth' is a company which is working since 2010 towards creating sustainable solutions to tackle with enormous waste generated in Pune and Pimpri Chinchwad cities. The Pune city alone generates 900-1000 tons of waste per day, out of which only 20% is recycled which is mainly plastic waste.

Dr Prakash Rao emphasized how urbanization has negatively impacted the environment and atmosphere. The concept of using energy efficiently, water management strategies and how the way we use transportation can be changed for the better. To decrease traffic congestion, and air pollution, and to enhance health, we should encourage sustainable transportation methods including walking, cycling, and public transportation. Create bike lanes, footpaths, and public transportation networks to encourage people to opt for these alternatives over driving, etc.

At last, Dr Om Prakash spoke about how there is no alternative to Earth and that whatever damage humans have done can be reversed if taken proper measures as he believes that every economy has an ability to manage its waste and actions. The main themes he highlighted were drivers of climate change, the increase in global temperature, the need for waste separation, solid waste management, landfill leachate and how is it related to the environment and humans. He presented various research on how different chemicals which are the result of urbanization cause the environment to degrade. He focuses on how different human actions lead to an increase in waste dumping in landfills. These landfills end up being a major cause of pollutants and contamination of land and water resources which directly harmfully impacts living beings.



Sir also presents a comparative view of sanitary and unprotected landfills and how different gases like CO2, N2O and other toxic gases are dispersed in the environment. He even suggested that the solution to make our city sustainable is to form a sustainable community by bringing diversity together, communicating and interacting while working towards a common goal of achieving sustainable living.

The program later had a Pune Climate Warrior section where two climate buddies explained the initiative which was proposed by Rajya Sabha MP Adv. Vandana Chavan and executed by Divya Chavan. The volunteer students rightly known as 'Climate Buddies' were felicitated by distributing certificates for their valuable contribution. The program further proceeded with the Avni presentation contest based on specific environmental and urbanization-related themes followed by prize distribution for PCW and winners of the Avni contest.




- Constitution Day : 26<sup>th</sup> November 2022
