Key Highlights of the Year: 2020-2021

REPORT ON NATIONAL WEBINAR ON THE NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY 2020 organized by Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce on 8th September, 2020.

Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce, Pune organized a National Webinar on the National Education Policy 2020 on Tuesday, 8th September 2020 with the theme 'revamping the higher education'. The webinar was organized with the intent to unfold the key developments in the new National Education policy.

The Chief Guest for the webinar was Shri Prakash Javadekar, the Union Minister of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Information & Broadcasting and Heavy Industries & Public Enterprises Government of India.

Shri Prakash Javadekar spoke about the designing and drafting process of the policy in a more democratic way by involvement of all stakeholders in the education field. Highlighting the five pillars of the new policy, affordability, accessibility, quality, equity, and accountability, he spoke on introducing a new dimension of flexibility through choice based education. He mentioned some novel concepts in the new policy such as Bank of credit-which allows anytime entry and exit to the student and Bachelor plus facility. According to him quality enhancement by harnessing the new technology is the essence of this policy. The policy also gives emphasis on research and innovation by increasing the expenditure on research, organizing more hackathons for students and encouraging dialogue between academia, industry and research lab. He spoke on increasing the Gross enrollment ration from 26% to 50% in 15 years and creation of new structure of four pillar organizations to overarch the higher education.

Dr. S. B. Mujumdar, Founder President Symbiosis appreciated the policy for its dynamism and innovative approach.

Dr. Vidya Yervadekar, Principal Director Symbiosis congratulated Shri Prakash Javadekar for being the architect of a pathbreaking National education policy.

Dr. S. G. Bapat, Chancellor Tilak Maharashtra University spoke on the research dimension in National Education Policy 2020. Dr. Varadaraj Bapat shared his views on the finance aspect of National Education Policy, 2020. Dr. Hrishikesh Soman spoke on the emphasis of Innovation and Creativity in the national education policy. Vice-principal of Symbiosis College, Dr. Sunayani Parchure proposed the vote of thanks for session one.

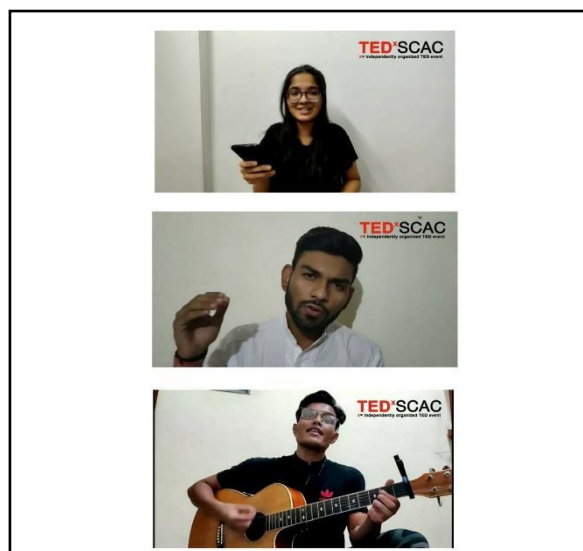

2. Financial Literacy Sessions

Date: 22nd to 26th February 2021

Participants: 86 Student Beneficiaries

The Centre for Skill Development and Departments of Economics & Banking had organized online training sessions on 'Financial Literacy/Awareness' funded by RUSA 2.0 held over a period of five days, commencing from 22nd of February to 26th February 2021. The Speaker for the event was Mr. Kanchan Kulkarni, ex-regional head (Maharashtra state), ICICI Bank Ltd. The Speaker highlighted the need to have financial awareness and basic banking and investment knowledge for a timely and better financial planning for an individual. The speaker introduced the nowadays widely used term 'Financial Literacy' and the importance of it and explained to participants Asset products of the banks. He explained the difference between fund-based credit facilities and non-fund based credit facilities. The Speaker also threw light on 'Digital Financial Literacy'. He discussed the multifaceted opportunities that online and mobile banking has brought to the modern-day society

3. International Skill Convention

Dates: 17th and 18th of February, 2021

Participants: 568 Student Beneficiaries

The two-day International Skill Convention organized by the Centre for Skill Development under the Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) aims to provide the students valuable insights in professional and interpersonal skills.

The Symbiosis College of Arts and Commerce under the Symbiosis Skill Center and Development organized the International Skill Convention on February 17, 2021 & February 18, 2021. The two-day convention had a total of Eight dignitaries and 568 Student participants from various colleges.

The event was inaugurated by Shri Pankaj Kumar, IAS, Project Director RUSA. He is also associated with Government of Higher and Technical Education under Govt. of Maharashtra. He has also been the Development Commissioner of Mumbai and the executive director of Maharashtra State faculty Development Academy.

The Following Speakers addressed to various issues concerning professional and interpersonal Skills

1. Mr. Pratyush Bhaskar, BFSI Expert : A Lifeskill called Financial Planning

Mr. Pratyush Bhaskar works in news story writing for Special Stories aired in News 24. Family. He stressed on the importance of financial planning and the need for it. 'Money doesn't buy happiness, money buys choices. It is what you do with those choices that makes you happy'. It is very important how we manage our money. Financial well-being is an important factor for happiness, health and peace. Return on investment is the most important element in financial planning. It is having adequate money to take care of your needs. There are three important considerations for any product: Returns, Safety and Liquidity.

2. Mr. Shagata Mukherjee, Behavioral Economics : Behavioral Skills & Decision Making.

Mr. Shagata Mukherjee spoke about behavioral science and skills. He said that humans have two systems, one automatic, which is a more relaxed one and reflective, which is more poised. We cannot belong to only one system; we are a blend of both. He further explained about heuristics, which is the rule of thumb, saying it might be helpful but there's no guarantee because it's more like a mental shortcut. He highlighted the topic with various types of heuristics such as anchoring, availability, optimism and overconfidence. He even casted light upon the problem of self-control that many people face saying it can be illuminated by planner-doer model, planner is someone far sighted where as doer cares about immediate future.

3. Ms. Rupali Patil, Social Impact Consultant- Social Sector Impact: The Soul & Technique

Ms. Rupali Patil spoke about the importance of choosing a career that we really want to pursue and that interests us. Taking up a career only because that is what everyone is doing tires us mentally and physically. She focused on asking we the question 'WHY' when choosing a specific career. Once we get the answer to this, our journey becomes interesting and satisfying. She stressed on the importance of finding the true calling of life, what is our passion and how

do we want to achieve our goals. The Speaker spoke about the options or the career opportunities available in the Social Impact Sector.

4. Mr. Tapan Mody, Copywriter, Creative Director & Career Coach - Unschooling - The School of Application

The founder of the Yes Why Not, recipient of various awards Mr. Tapan Mody, drew attention towards how temples of information should be armed with applicability to achieve success. The speaker drew a comparison of student life to a tree and focused on how schooling and unschooling is important where schooling is the temple of information and unschooling is the temple of application. The more information we acquire the more we should be able to apply and further sow the seeds for the future generation for them to savor the fruits of education.

5.MR. ADITYA AGARWAL: Unfolding obstacles to take a leap forward.

The current pandemic has made us realize that nothing is in our control except our body and health. This pandemic has hit the lower strata of the society very harshly. The Speaker threw light on the fact that even today post the pandemic there are ample opportunities available in the market. We must focus on our duty to sharpen and harness our inter-personal skills and go out and explore more. One of the most important questions asked by the students was, 'Should we go for further studies or a job post the graduation?' In the speaker's opinion, students should go for jobs as education can be done within any time frame, however good opportunities cannot. The speaker stressed on the importance of humility in life.

6.MS MITHA SENGUPTA: Not Just IQ and EQ, but LQ

The speaker spoke about IQ, EQ and LQ. The speaker mentioned that human intelligence is very complex. People aware with their emotional quotient tend to be a good listener. She shared some of her career experiences and talked about her journey. She believes that there should be balance between our IQ and EQ. but along with that LQ- learning quotient, is the important one in today's world. That one should grow, adapt and evolve according to the changing world. We should always walk side by side the digital world.

7.MS. SARYU SAHAJPAL : Accountability and Ownership

The session started with Ms. Saryu Sahajpal asking the participants about the two main words relevant to the session OWNERSHIP and ACCOUNTABILITY. After that she briefly defined the two words mentioning how we expect only good things happening to us and start

questioning everything around when something bad happens to us. The Speaker showed the participants a short but very beautiful and meaningful video that focused on how taking responsibility and team work can solve problems. The Speaker focused on the sentence- “Life is only 10% of what happens and 90% of how we react to it.”

8.MS. URVASHI PRASAD: Relevance of skills in Higher education

The Speaker is Public Policy Specialist NITI AYOJ for transforming India and has Co-authored India’s first national review presented at the United Nations in 2017. Mentioning that only 2.4 percent of the labour work force has received vocational/formal training, much lesser than that of China, US, Japan and South Korea. India needs to bridge the gap between the education system and employability through skilling.

There is a need of much more quality skilling and training. Various skills and initiatives have been taken including Polytechnics, courses, recognition of prior learning, bridge-training short-term training such as PMKVY look to build in greater participation of states have a much more demand driven model for skill. We have a long way to go as far as the implementation is concerned. Speaker stressed on Meaningful skilling and reskilling senior citizens and specially abled to engage them in the economy.

The Trainer was Ms. Antara Bhadury, BFSI Specialist and Corporate Trainer. Industry expert explained that people always expect to seek some of your time when they meet you and your attention is needed. She also spoke about composure to bounce back from the goof ups and how to keep away the distractions and check the set up before entering an online interaction. She also explained the importance of networking and formatting an email, checking the grammar, proofreading before hitting send are very essential skills in today’s world and thus, she explained those in a detailed manner.

Placement Cell Report 2020-21

Symbiosis College of Arts & Commerce (SCAC), well known for its placements, conducts a good number of on-campus drives for both undergraduate, and postgraduate students. The placement season begins as early as August. Headed by Dr. Yogini Chiplunkar, assisted by Hrithik Goudar, Shayantani Kundu and Ayushi Tyagi, the placement cell guides, trains, and supports the students throughout the year for these drives. Despite the Covid pandemic, till 31th July 2021, the placement cell has successfully placed a total of 114 students. Currently, six companies' recruitment is in process and soon we will receive final updates from them giving us the details of students recruited from SCAC. Hrithik, Shayantani and Ayushi, the placement cell student coordinators, have played key roles in the process of conducting the virtual placement drives. They worked behind the scenes and were responsible for informing the students about the drive, taking the registrations, attracting new companies, and much more, all through various online platforms and ensuring a smooth flow of the drive while assisting the group of recruiters by continuously connecting them with the college.

The placement session for the academic year 2020-21 was unprecedented owing to the pandemic. Shifting from offline to an online platform of recruitment had its pros and cons for both, companies and the placement cell. It was challenging indeed but what we all have done over the past year is strive to find the best in us and grow through the challenges. As a placement cell, we owe the success of the procedure throughout the year to the cooperation of the coordinators, faculty and the students.

The companies that visited the campus were Deloitte USI, Deutsche Bank, Northern Trust, TresVista, Credit Suisse, Ernst and Young GDS, Teach for India, EY India, ElasticRun, XqtiV Healthcare, Capgemini and GOMO Group offering positions varying from Audit Assistant, Tax Analyst, Assurance & Financial Associate, HR Analyst, Business Compliance, Business Development Executive, Teacher Fellowship, And SEO Analyst.

The procedure for selection includes receiving the job description, registration of students, pre-placement talk, aptitude test, group discussions, rounds of interviews, the final selection of students and acceptance of offer letters.

Prior to the dawn of placement season, a three-day placement workshop was conducted to familiarize the students with the placement procedure. The workshop covered essential basics and gave significant tips on Resume Writing, conducted mock Group Discussions, and gave insights on how to present oneself in a Personal Interview. The guest speakers who assisted the students were Ms Devaki Purohit, Ms Gunjan Deshpande, Mr Akshat Bhatnagar and Ms Snehal Sarkar.

A session was also conducted by the coordinators to help the second-year students have a thorough understanding of the placement process and the role of the placement cell of our college. The aim was to guide them about how to prepare oneself for the placements, with the hope that some fruitful contributions were made on our part.

Till date during the academic year of 2020-21, a total of 12 companies have approached us, including 5 new companies, with ElasticRun, Xqtiv Healthcare, SKS Business Services, Capgemini and GOMO Group being the newest addition to the list.

The placement cell recorded a total of 114 students till date getting placed during 2020-21. The highest CTC offered to PG students was Rs. 6.05 LPA and to UG students was Rs. 5.50 LPA. During 2019-20 the highest number of students were placed, this year due to the pandemic there was a slight drop in the same. The average package for PG students and UG Students was Rs. 4.50 LPA and Rs. 3.71 LPA respectively.

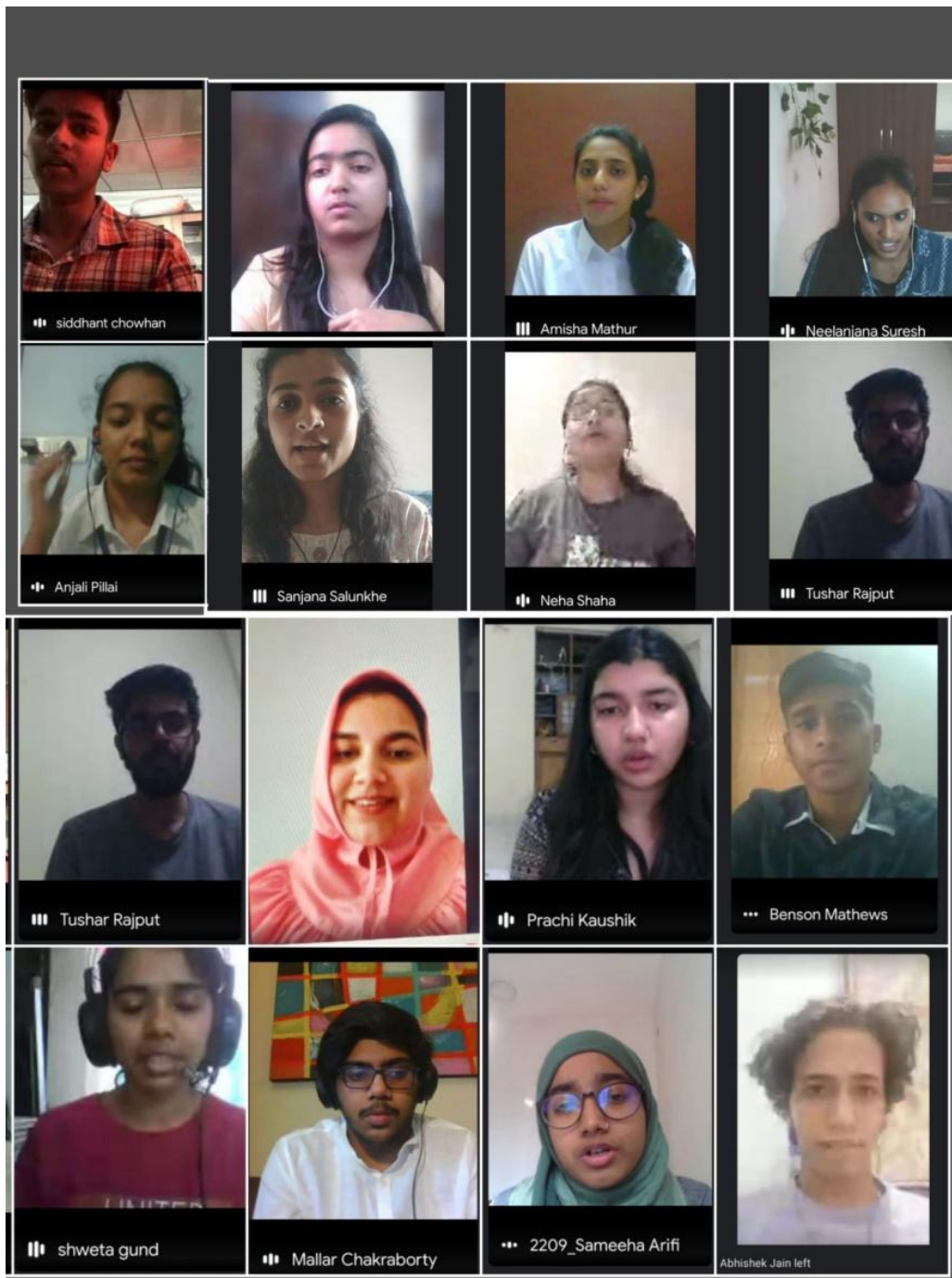

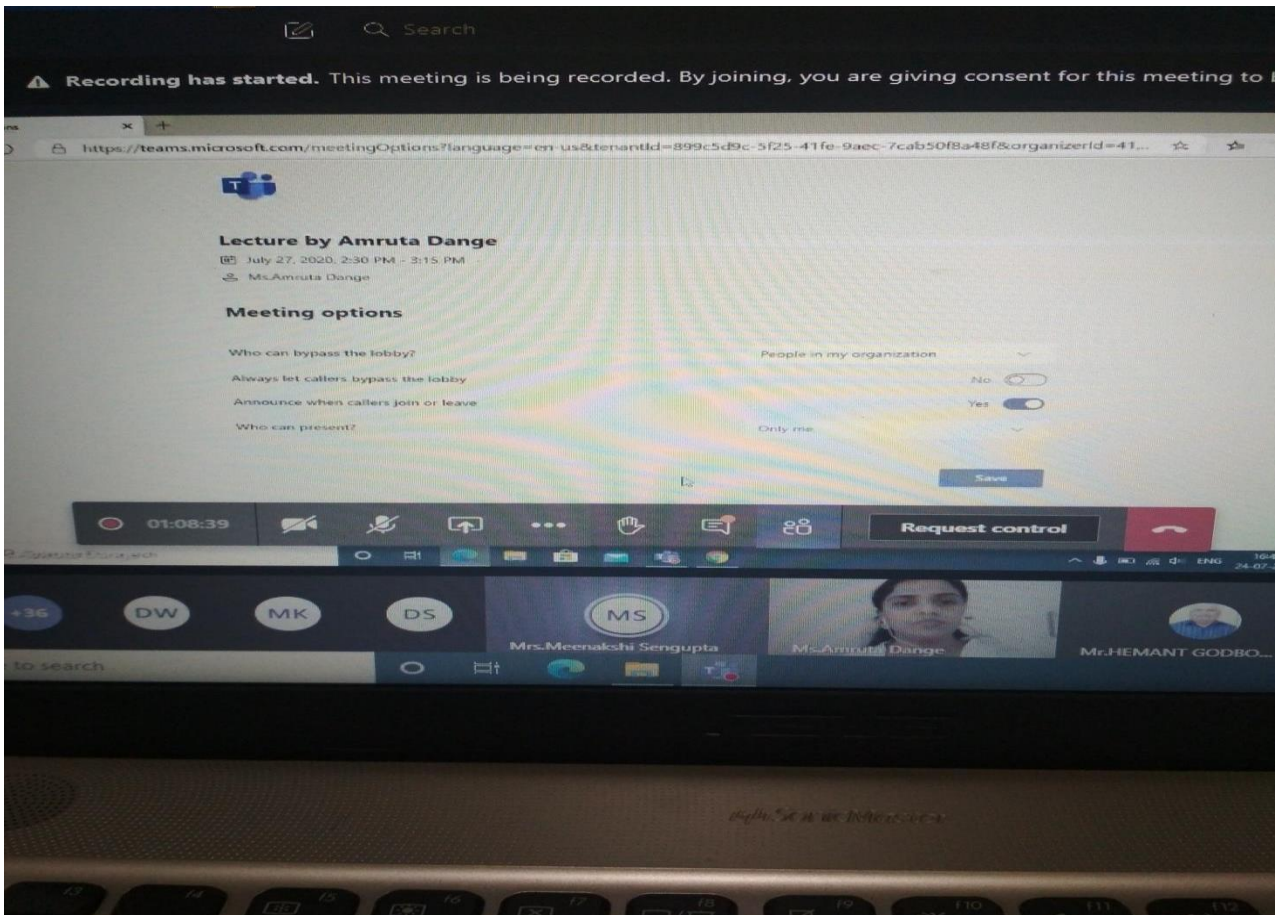
Activities organized:

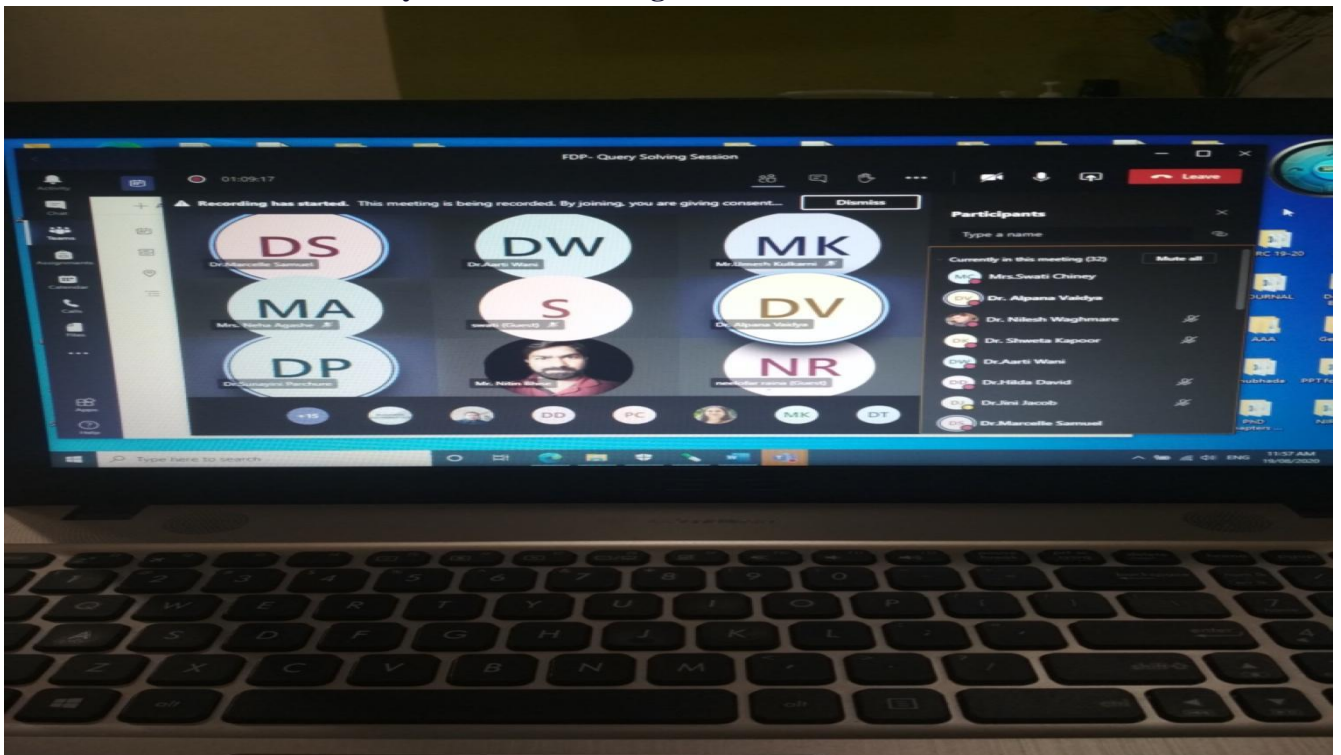

New Examination committee has been constituted from 1st January 2021 comprising of Dr. Yogini Chiplunkar, Controller of Examinations, Dr. Shubhada Tahmankar, Honours Incharge, Mrs. Ashwini Kothari, Assistant Controller of Examination, DR. Neha Agashe and Mr. Aniruddha Sharma.

Mr. Annaso Desai has joined in the Examination section. The charge of PG examination was handed over to Mrs. Vrushali Jadav

The activities performed by the Examination Cell during 2020-21 are summarized as follows. This information relates to the overall performance of the Examination Cell for F.Y., S.Y., T.Y. B.Com/B.A., M.Com, M.A Part I, Part II and Degree with Honours Program examinations, for approximately a total of 4000 students.

As per the notification received from UGC and Government of Maharashtra, First year and second year students of UG and first year students of PG were promoted due to Covid Pandemic for April 2020 Examinations.

The examinations of Final year students of UG and PG and Backlog examinations of all semesters were conducted online during September/ October 2020. Open Book Examination pattern was used for these exams and exams were conducted using Google classrooms.

The Academic year of 2020-21 was started in the last week of August 2020. The Regular and Backlog Examinations of Semester 1,3 and 5, and Backlog examinations of semester 2,4 and 6 of UG and Regular and Backlog of semester 3 and backlog of semester 1,2,4 of PG were held between 4th January to 4th February 2021 Open Book Examination pattern was used for these exams and exams were conducted using Google classrooms.

College introduced 70-30 pattern to the first year students of BA and BCom. Accordingly, Internal Assessment of 70 Marks per subject was done by the subject teachers and 30 Marks Semester end examination was conducted.

The regular semester end and backlog examinations of Semester 2,4 and 6 and Backlog examinations of Semester 1,3 and 5 of UG and Regular and Backlog examinations of Semester 1 and 4 and backlog examinations of semester 2 and 3 of PG courses were conducted from 8th May 2021. Online Open book examination format was used for these exams. And these exams were conducted using google classroom. Due to covid pandemic there was lockdown in Pune and college admin staff as well as teachers were working from home during the period of examinations. So, after taking the review of the covid situation, college decided to give priority to health and safety of staff and teachers. And, it was decided to conduct these online exams from Home. For this a detailed procedure and system incorporating all required checks and balances was devised. To explain all the details of the process, separate meetings/training sessions of UG faculty, PG faculty and admin staff were conducted. In true sense we conducted these exams online as all subject teachers, custodian, senior supervisors, teacher coordinators and supporting office staff worked from home for these exams. With their support and cooperation these exams were successfully concluded on 4th June 2021 without any challenge.

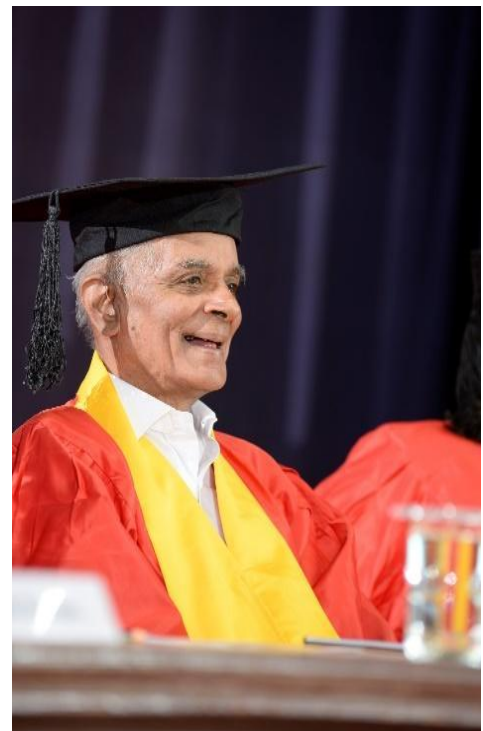
Healthy practices... A noteworthy point to be appreciated:

6. Training Session were conducted for conducting open book examination from Home for all UG, Honours, Interdisciplinary faculties on 7th May 2021, for Administrative staff on 8th May 2021 and for PG faculties on 15th May 2021 by Dr. Yogini Chiplunkar and Mrs. Ashwini Kothari.
7. Before beginning of these exams a timeline was prepared to declare the results in 40 days from conclusion of examination. All the results were declared on time.
8. Examination Concessions to Diyang Students will be given and the information regarding the same has been uploaded on the college website.

10. Guidelines for Internal Assessment for the academic year 2021-22 has been prepared and will be shared with all the faculties.

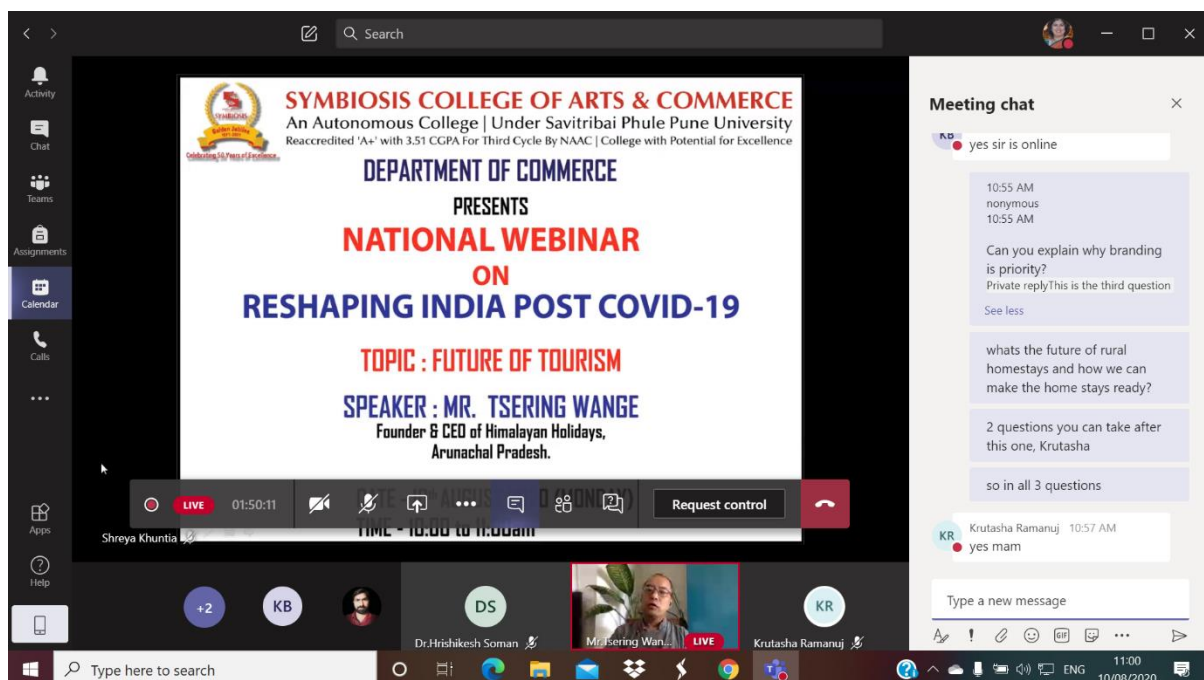

Research Projects

A short term Research Project was undertaken by Dr Yogini Chiplunkar and Dr. Shubhada Tamhankar. The title of this research project was "A Study of Financial Literacy Among Members of Women Self- Help Groups (SHG) in Pune City".

This research project is based on OECD's model of measuring financial literacy. Through this research an attempt has been made to measure the financial literacy of members of women self-help groups, study socio-economic factors that have positively affected score of their financial literacy and identify a component (from financial attitude, financial behaviour and financial knowledge) as a predictor of financial literacy of members of women self-help groups. The study is based on data collected from 104 members of 35 women self-help groups from Pune city. The findings of the study depict that two third women under study have low level of financial literacy. Among the socio-economic factors, education, income and active saving are positively correlated with financial literacy and financial behaviour is predicting 68.3% score of financial literacy of women under study. The analysed findings of the study have shown the need to take necessary measures to improve financial knowledge of members of women self-help groups to improve their financial literacy and financial wellbeing. This research project was completed in the academic year 2020-21.

Title of this research paper was “Measuring financial literacy and identifying a predictive component: A study of women self-help groups”
- Research Project Completed:
A short-term Research Project was undertaken by Dr Yogini Chiplunkar and Dr Shubhada Tamhankar. The title of this research project was “A Study of Financial Literacy Among Members of Women Self- Help Groups (SHG) in Pune City”. This research project is based on OECD’s model of measuring financial literacy. Through this research an attempt has been made to measure the financial literacy of members of women self-help groups, study socio-economic factors that have positively affected score of their financial literacy and identify a component (from financial attitude, financial behavior and financial knowledge) as a predictor of financial literacy of members of women self-help groups. The study is based on data collected from 104 members of 35 women self-help groups from Pune city. The findings of the study depict that two third women under study have low level of financial literacy. Among the socio-economic factors, education, income and active saving are positively correlated with financial literacy and financial behavior is predicting 68.3% score of financial literacy of women under study. The analyzed findings of the study have shown the need to take necessary measures to improve financial knowledge of members of women self-help groups to improve their financial literacy and financial wellbeing. This research project was completed in the academic year 2020-21.
