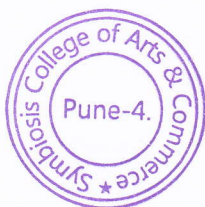

"Intercultural perspectives on information literacy"

in winter term 2020/2021

A joint online learning endeavour was carried out in the winter term of 2020/2021 by Symbiosis College of Arts & Commerce, Pune and the Institute of Information Science and Language Technology at the University of Hildesheim, Germany. The purpose of the learning scenario was to foster intercultural learning and information literacy.

Students individually had to learn about basics of scientific literacy and collaboratively constructed knowledge on one of four research topics, namely "Information behaviour in Corona times", "What I believe is surely true.' How to correct cognitive errors to promote an open mind", "The Impact of the pandemic on the education sector", "How to cultivate information literacy in rural environments" To learn about basics of scientific literacy, students had to build a common ground on prerequisites and skills with regard to academic work. For the collaborative knowledge construction on a specific research topic, students had to search, read, summarize and reflect on the state of the art literature and conduct interviews with local users. Finally, on January 30th 2021 students shared the group's knowledge with the "world" in an online conference.

We hereby confirm that Senapati, Trupti participated in the Joint Learning Endeavor "Intercultural perspectives on information literacy" in winter term 2020/2021.

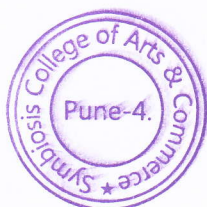
